Wanted: Church Musician

## **Job Description**

The Vergennes Congregational Church, United Church of Christ is an Open and Affirming congregation of 135 members that is seeking a Church Musician. We are a vibrant, Christian community—full of life, music, and laughter. We have a long history of deeply appreciating the gifts of our staff in supporting an inclusive, loving, and compassionate ministry in the heart of our little city.

We seek a skilled musician that is comfortable with the classics and new pieces that grow our appreciation of the diverse ways to worship God through music. The successful applicant will be a team player, eager to collaborate with other musicians inside and outside of our community to enrich our music ministry. The church has a beloved <u>9-rank 1879 Hook and Hastings tracker organ</u> and an upright Kawai piano in the sanctuary, and a Yamaha digital keyboard in the choir room. A devoted choir performs weekly in the sanctuary. In addition to having excellent keyboard skills, proficiency in other instruments will be greatly appreciated.

This year-round position is salaried and part-time. The expectation of attendance is for choir practice (8:15 am), Sunday worship services (9:30 am), and other special services, including (but not limited to) Christmas Eve and Easter. The work is done cooperatively, especially with the Choir Director(s) and Pastor. As a central part of the musical leadership team of the church, the Church Musician is expected to advocate for the music ministry.

### **Job Requirements**

1. Keyboard ability sufficient to play hymns, songs, and anthem accompaniments. Ability to sight-read and improvise is desired.

- 2. Willingness to learn to play the organ.
- 3. Knowledge of basic music theory and ability to perform simple transpositions or harmonizations.
- 4. Willingness to rehearse sufficiently to maintain a high quality of music.
- 5. Sensitivity and the ability to interact with a variety of people.
- 6. Ability to take direction and work as a team member.
- 7. Ability to communicate well and in a friendly manner with the church leadership, church choir, and members of the congregation.
- 8. Desire to maintain a constant program of self-improvement.

## Responsibilities:

- 1. Support the church's worship environment through the well-prepared execution of music.
- 2. Serve as accompanist for the Vergennes Congregational Choir in regular and special rehearsals and performances as required. Rehearsals typically begin at 8:15 am. Worship begins at 9:30 am and usually lasts 60-75 minutes.
- 3. Facilitate congregational singing and worship through the excellent execution of hymns and other songs.
- 4. Plan, select, and prepare preludes, postludes and offertories according to the needs of the worship services.
- 5. Play for weddings and funerals, as requested (and upon availability), and be permitted to receive additional compensation from the parties involved.
- 6. Maintain an accurate account of organ needs and maintenance and notify the tuning company when needed.
- 7. Find a substitute for Sundays when not available.

### Compensation:

- 1. Salary \$8,000-\$10,000 per year dependent upon qualifications, experience, and availability.
- 2. Four weeks of paid vacation per year
- 3. Reimbursement of up to \$500 per year for professional expenses
- 4. This position offers opportunities to play for additional events such as marriages, funerals, and memorial services.

### Accountability:

The Church Musician is accountable to the Pastor. The Church Musician will need to notify the Pastor a minimum of three weeks prior to planned absences (preferably as soon as known) and is responsible for finding a substitute when not available.

### **Background Check:**

The applicant will be required to participate in a background check (paid for by the church). The final offer will be contingent on the results of that check.
